Dan Bachman to Speak at Spring Banquet Saturday, April 2

After this long winter, we are looking forward to spring and growing daylilies. So please join us on April 2 for our annual spring banquet. Things that people will want to grow in their gardens for years because they not only look good but perform well. We specialize mostly in spider/uf types in both tet and dip but have gone a few other directions lately. My talk will be titled THE GOSPEL ACCORDING TO DAN. I will tell how and why I do things and give my gospel."

Another thing I always do this time of year is register for the National; this year in Louisville. It is time I get moving on that. I better bundle up and head out in the cold to the post office!




National Arboretum Volunteers Needed




